CURRENT KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS WILL NOT ATTEND SCHOOL ON APRIL 8.

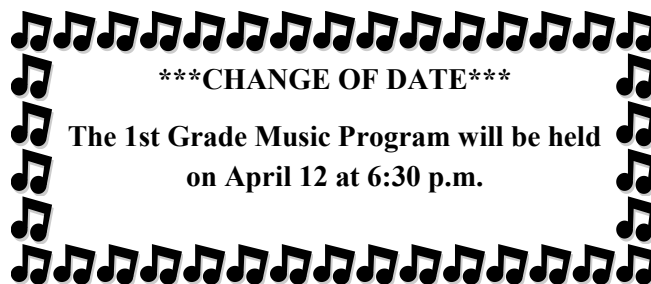
