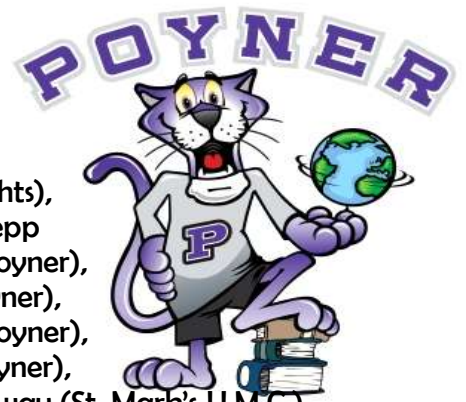

New supports at Poyner? Barbie Bass informed member of some of the new changes and supports here at Poyner.

- Reading Coach, Jessica Martin – full time providing the staff with professional development on IDM, running records, quick-reads, working on testing and monitoring students, meeting with grade level teams weekly during their reading data team meetings, co-teaching, and modeling of reading strategies.
- Family Support Worker, John Barker – working with high-risk students and their families, meeting monthly on student monitoring, providing transportation when needed, attendance concerns, and helping families get more involved in their child's education.
- Interventions for Students – students not reaching proficiency after core instruction are receiving supplemental and intensive supports/reteaching throughout the day. After-school tutoring to help students.
- Safety – discussed monthly during PBIS meeting and as needed. Fire evacuation drills and tornado drills done 2 times each semester, lockdown drill annually and as needed for review, evacuation to alternate site done every other year. Was done last year, so not needed this year.

PTO Update – PTO cleaned and organized closet area, and is in need of donations for the Holiday Shop (Dec. 12-16), as well as volunteers.

Red Ribbon needs – Oct. 28 from 2:15-3:15 students will be on their Red Ribbon Parade in costume to “Say Boo To Drugs.” The City of Evansdale will be providing the red ribbons and suckers for each student.
