ADMINISTRATOR NAMED FOR HOOVER MIDDLE SCHOOL

WATERLOO – The Board of Education will receive a recommendation from the Superintendent to appoint Mike Landers as the new assistant principal for Hoover Middle School for the 2011-12 school year.

Landers will succeed Steve Thune who is being recommended as the principal for Irving Elementary for the 2011-12 school year. Landers has a Master of Arts in Educational Administration, Pre-K-12 Principalship, from the University of Northern Iowa; a Bachelor of Science in Secondary Education, with an emphasis in US history and sociology from Upper Iowa; and an Associate Arts degree in general studies from Hawkeye Community College.

Landers served as the interim assistant principal at Hoover during the absence of Steve Thune this year. He is currently teaching 8th grade social studies at Hoover as well as coaching at West and Hoover. He has been teaching at Hoover since 2005 and was an interim administrative assistant at West High.

The new administrative assignment will be effective for the 2011-12 school year.
