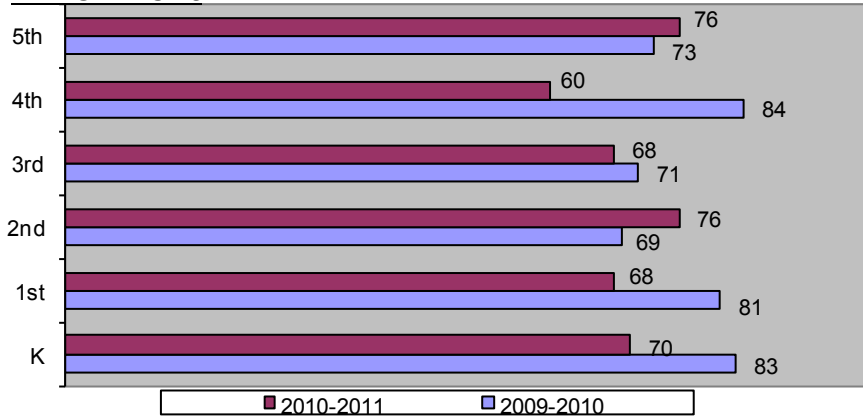

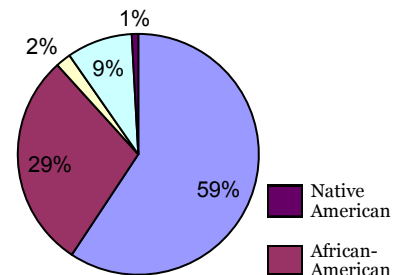


2010-2011 Average Class Size

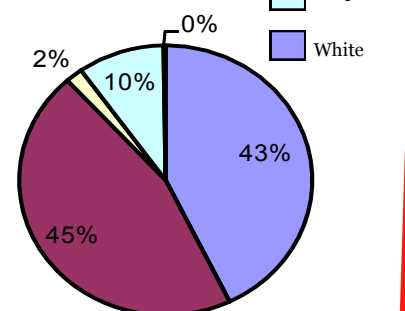

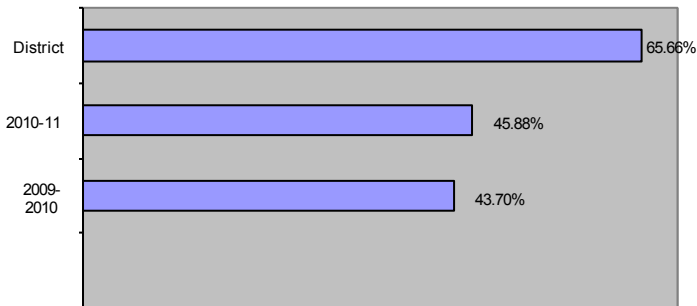

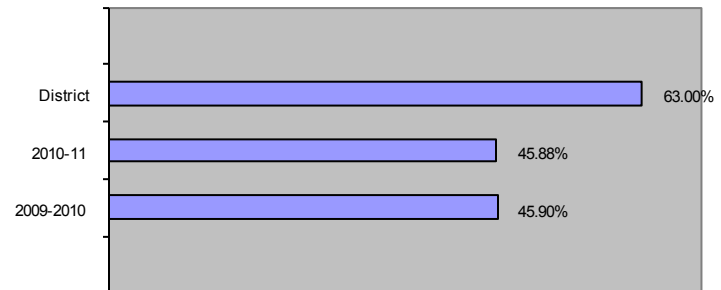

Figures are based on average percent for grades 3-5. Students who score at or above the 41st percentile on the ITBS are considered "proficient." Our goal is to continue to increase the percentage of our students who meet this minimum standard.

Lincoln 2011-2012 Goals

Goal: The FAY test scores of non-proficient students on the Reading Comprehension test currently in grades 3, 4, and 5 will increase by 10% as measured by the Spring 2012 ITBS.

Goal: The FAY test scored of non-proficient minority students currently in grades 3, 4, and 5 on the Reading Comprehension test will increase by 10% on the Spring 2012 ITBS scores.

Goal: The percent of non-proficient Entitled Individuals on the Reading Comprehension test currently in grades 3, 4, and 5 will decrease by 10%.

Goal: The FAY test scores of non-proficient students in Math currently in grades 3, 4, and 5 will increase by 7% as measured by the Spring 2012 ITBS test.

Goal: The FAY test scores of non-proficient minority students in Math currently in grades 3, 4, and 5 will increase by 10% on the Spring 2012 ITBS test.
