## **OPEN ENROLLMENT DEADLINES FOR 2012-2013 SCHOOL YEAR**

WATERLOO - Parents or guardians who wish to apply for open enrollment of their child into or out of the Waterloo Community School District for the 2012-2013 school year must submit an application by March 1, 2012, with the exception of parents of kindergarten students (beginning school in the fall of 2012) and those who have good cause for late filing. These two groups have until September 1, 2012, to file their applications.

Parents and guardians need to be aware of possible loss of athletic eligibility for open enrolled students. Transportation to and from the new district is the responsibility of the parent, however, assistance will be provided to students who qualify for free or reduced price lunches. Approvals are limited by the District's diversity guidelines.

For Waterloo District residents, applications can be completed and turned in at the Education Service Center, 1516 Washington St., Waterloo, 50702 by March 1, 2012, or mailed with a postmark of March 1, 2012, or before.
