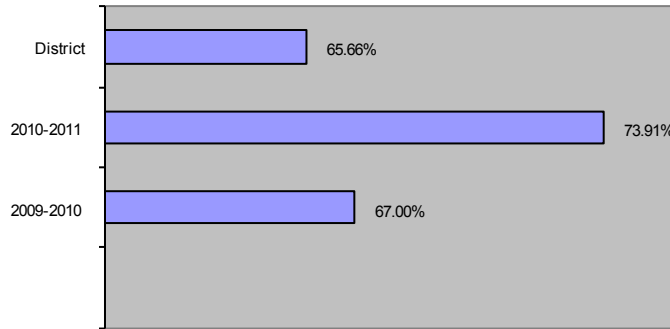

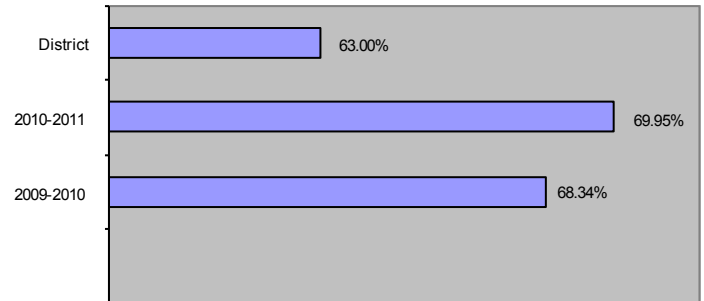

Reading and Math Proficiency

Figures are based on average percent for grades 3-5. Students who score at or above the 41st percentile on the ITBS are considered "proficient." Our goal is to continue to increase the percentage of our students who meet this minimum standard.

Poyner 2010-2011 Goal Report

Reading Goals:

- The percent of grade 3-5 FAY students scoring at proficiency or higher in Reading Comprehension will increase at least 18.7% (from 63.3% to 82%) as measured by the Spring 2010 Iowa Test of Basic Skills subtest.
- One hundred percent of students in grades K-5 will be at or above instructional level on the Spring DRA2 (Kindergarten-4, 1st grade-16, 2nd grade-28, 3rd grade-38, 4th grade-40, 5th grade-50).

Math Goals:

- The percent of grade 3-5 FAY students scoring at proficiency or higher in Math Total was increase at least 13.3% (from 66.7% to 81.0%) as measured by the Spring 2010 Iowa Test of Basic Skills subtest.
- One hundred percent of grade K-2 students will be proficient on the End of Year math test.

Climate/Culture Goals:

- Being the school year implementation of Positive Behavior Support.
- Decrease office referrals by 25%.
