TROLLEY KIDS SET TO BEGIN

WATERLOO – The Trolley Kids program provides a safe and reliable form of summer transportation to parks, pools, golf courses, public libraries and youth serving agencies in Waterloo and Evansdale for youth between the ages of 7 and 14 years of age. The program is a collaboration of youth serving agencies that responded to the lack of transportation for area youth. Service will begin on Tuesday, June 14 and end on Thursday, July 28.

Partnering with Metropolitan Transit Authority, the trolley will run on Tuesdays and Thursdays in June and July (except for July 5) between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. There are 2 routes (Red – West Waterloo and Blue – East Waterloo and Evansdale). Both routes start and stop at the Waterloo Center for the Arts at the top of each hour, travel a fixed route, stop in many neighborhoods in the city of Waterloo and Evansdale and return to the Center for the Arts. From sports to stories there is something for everyone on the Trolley Kids route! Cost is 10 cents per ride.
